## PSCCW responses during the period of aggression on Gaza

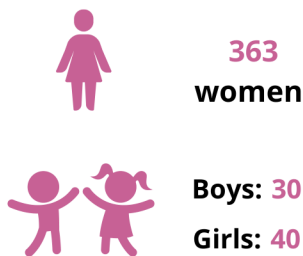
October 7, to November 30, 2023

Since October 7th, PSCCW has actively implemented interventions in various locations across the West Bank, including Hebron, Bethlehem, Salfit, Jenin, Ramallah, Nablus, and Qalqilya. These efforts involve engaging with women, men, and children, with a particular focus on the refugee camps and areas C.

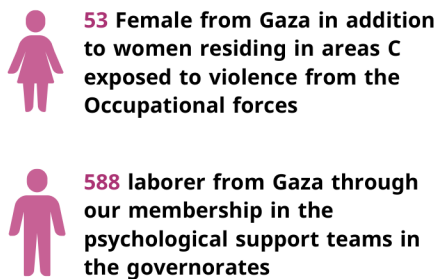
The interventions included Gazan women who were forcibly expelled from Israeli hospitals in Jerusalem and are currently residing in the West Bank to complete their medical treatment. Additionally, the interventions extended to laborers who were expelled from their jobs within Israel.

PSCCW provided its services which involve legal aid, individual and group counselling sessions, case management, raising awareness and relief assistance for **2718** individual

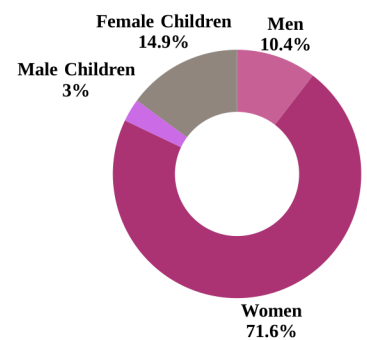

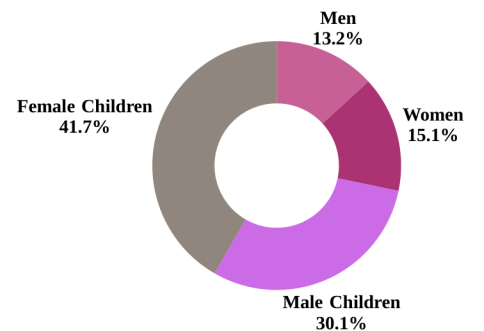

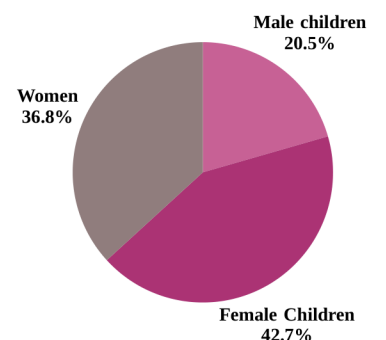
### MHPSS (Individual Counselling)
